- Get more people to take advantage of those resources
- Mobilize and activate residents to help, too







#### Who can apply? SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES

- Nonprofits
- Grassroots Groups
- Residents
- Small neighborhood-based organizations
- Faith-based organizations
- Civic and other community-serving organizations





# Who can apply? SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES

- Grassroots Groups: Formal or informal community-based organizations of residents leading projects and providing services to their community.
  - Based in and serves a neighborhood impacted by gun violence
  - Leaders with lived experience that informs their work
  - Strong relationships, access and credibility with residents
  - Experience organizing and providing services and activities for their community
  - \$500,000 or less annual budget
  - 15 people or fewer on staff





# What can get funded? SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES

#### **Service Areas**

- High-risk Interventionists: Place credible, trusted adults in communities to safely intervene and break the cycle of violence.
- Reentry Services: Support individuals returning from incarceration to successfully rejoin the community and achieve a positive, fresh start.
- Mental Health & Victim Outreach Services: Provide mental health and supportive resources for survivors and individuals impacted by gun violence.





# What can get funded? SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES

#### **Grassroots Groups**

- Can apply within any of the three Service Areas
- Programs and projects that develop and/or expand community-rooted efforts to reduce violence and/or improve safety in communities are also eligible:
  - STEAM-focused activities
  - Youth health and wellness activities
  - College and post-secondary prep
- Employment, internship and entrepreneurship support
- Food security and education programs

# Collaborate SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES

- We encourage applicants to include diverse partners and collaborators to strengthen their proposal. Consider:
  - Diversity of experience and thought
  - Organization staff/leadership
  - Communities served
- To improve existing infrastructure, the Foundation will encourage collaborations with other organizations to enhance their programs' effectiveness





#### How large are these grants? SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES

- Your funding request should reflect the proposed program's budget and the applicant's past organizational budget
- \$500,000 is the maximum grant size
- We want to distribute these funds widely





#### Capacity Building Support SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES

- The Foundation will fund at least one entity to provide capacity-building, training and technical assistance to funded organizations and groups
- We want to ensure organizations are successful in implementing their project and positioned for increased funding in the future





## Evaluating Applications SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES

The Foundation will award grants to applicants that meet the eligibility criteria and whose proposal best achieves the overall SSC Program's goals.

- Approach (45 points)
- Relevant Experience, Past Performance, and Qualifications (20 points)
- Data Collection and Evaluation (15 points)
- Proposer's Budget and Financial Stability (10 points)
- Applicant's Funding Request (10 points)




