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The Partners **SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES**

- Launched through a groundbreaking partnership between The Carrie Meek Foundation and Miami-Dade County
- Funding from the Miami-Dade County Community Violence Intervention Initiative
- 3-year collaboration with Miami-Dade County Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Safety

The Goals

SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES

- Increase availability of resources
- Get more people to take advantage of those resources
- Mobilize and activate residents to help, too



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Funded Service Areas

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- **High-risk Interventionists:** Place credible, trusted adults in communities to safely intervene and break the cycle of violence.
- **Reentry Services:** Support individuals returning from incarceration to successfully rejoin the community and achieve a positive, fresh start.
- **Mental Health & Victim Outreach Services:** Provide mental health and supportive resources for survivors and individuals impacted by gun violence.
- **Grassroots Groups:** Community-rooted solutions to reduce violence and/or improve safety in communities.



The Funding **SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES**

The Supporting Safer Communities Program includes investing an amount not to exceed \$140,000 to provide capacity building and technical assistance to funded community organizations and grassroots groups. Services will be provided in direct support of grantees awarded through the SSC Program.

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SSC Applicants

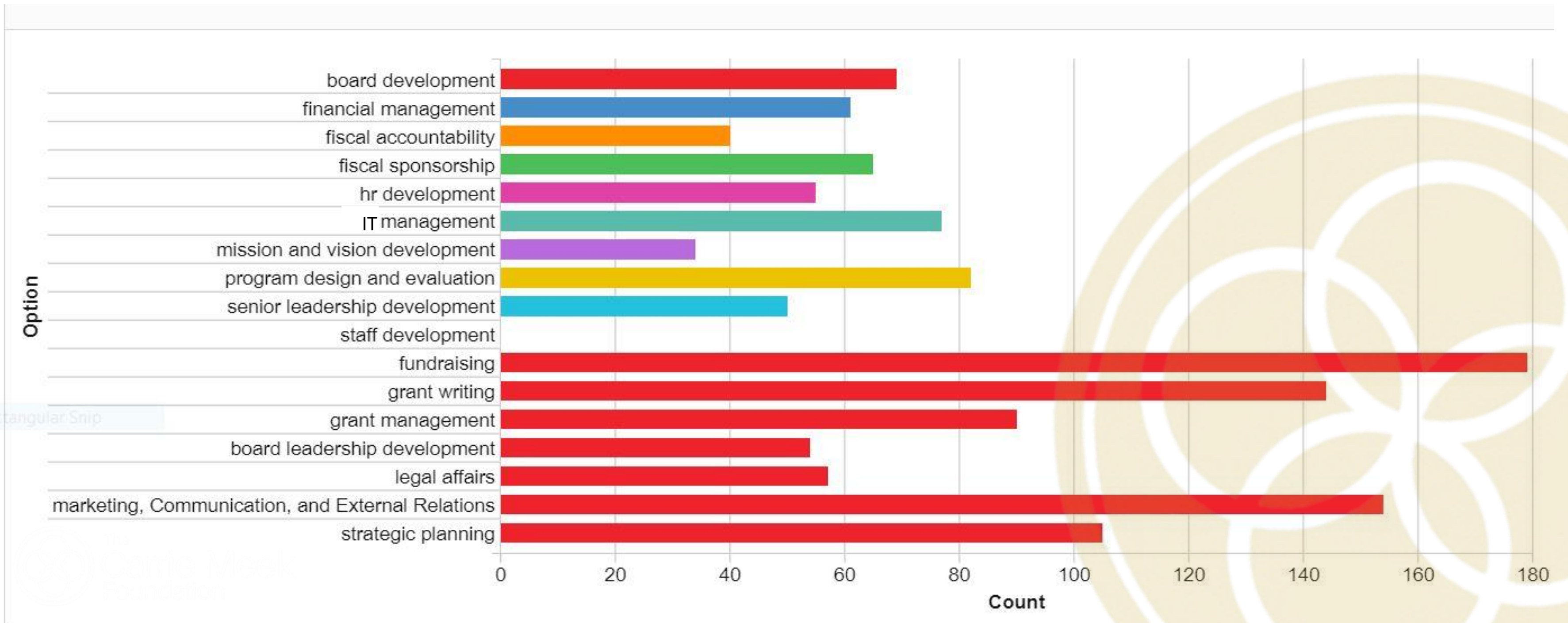
SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES

- 246 applicants applied.
- 13 individuals applied for the SSC Grant.
- 188 of the applicants stated that they were Grassroots.
- 74 of the applicants did not receive any funding last fiscal year.
- 60% of our applicants selected community-rooted solutions.
- Mental Health, Reentry, and High-Risk Interventions were almost evenly chosen as service areas.

- Establish a timeline of activities and communication checkpoints with CMF



TA Expectations

SUPPORTING SAFER COMMUNITIES

- Conduct a minimum of one group session with grantees (monthly)
- Conduct a minimum one-on-one sessions with each grantees (monthly)
- Conduct at the minimum one peer-to-peer session (quarterly)
- Provide technical assistance hours to grantees throughout the grant cycle.
- Build authentic relationships with grantees

1		Budget Narrative	Estimated Cost	Budget Line Explanation
2	Needs Assessment			This cost covers the process of determining the skills and knowledge of the staff and identifying areas that require improvement in order to develop a suitable training program.
3	Training Materials			This cost covers the development or purchase of materials, such as manuals, presentations, and handouts, required to deliver the training sessions.
4	Salaries/Trainer Fee			This cost covers the fees to be paid to the trainers or consultants who will deliver the training.
5	Travel and Accommodation			This cost covers the expenses for travel and accommodation for trainers and participants who need to travel to attend the training.
6	Technology and Equipment			This cost covers the purchase or rental of any equipment or technology required for the training, such as laptops, projectors, and audio-visual equipment.
7	Monitoring and Evaluation			This cost covers the process of evaluating the effectiveness of the training after it has been completed, such as surveys, interviews, and focus groups.

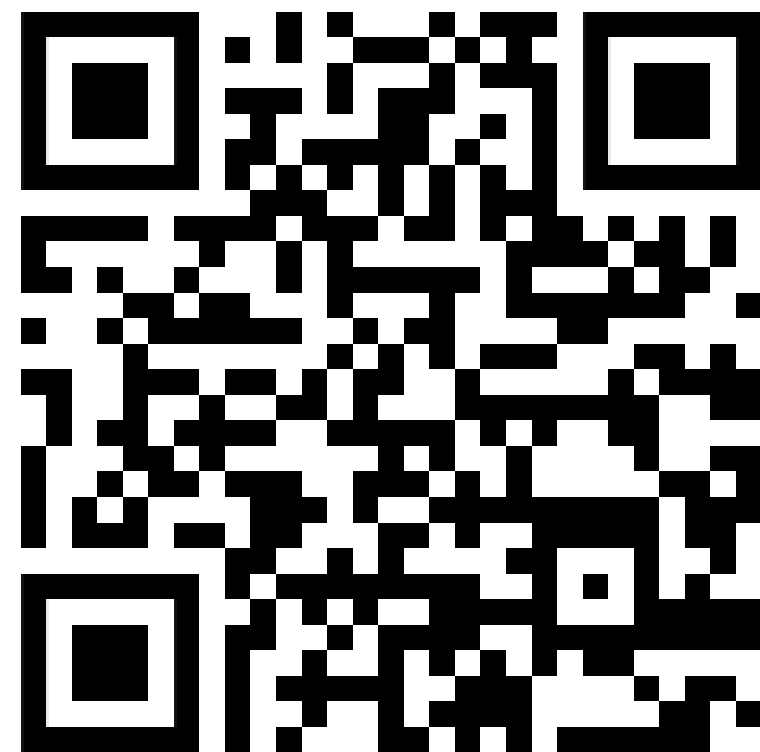
